Court Security Improvement Act of 2007

18 USC § 119 (Publish Personal Information)

5 yrs+fine

(a) **In General.** — Whoever knowingly makes restricted personal information about a covered person, or a member of the immediate family of that covered person, publicly available — (1) with the intent to threaten, intimidate, or incite the commission of a crime of violence against that covered person, or a member of the immediate family of that covered person; or

(2) with the intent and knowledge that the restricted personal information will be used to threaten, intimidate, or facilitate the commission of a crime of violence against that covered person, or a member of the immediate family of that covered person,

shall be fined under this title, imprisoned not more than 5 years, or both.

18 USC § 1521 (Filing False Liens)

Whoever files, attempts to file, or conspires to file, in any public record or in any private record which is generally available to the public, any false lien or encumbrance against the real or personal property of an individual described in section <u>1114</u>, on account of the performance of official duties by that individual, knowing or having reason to know that such lien or encumbrance is false or contains any materially false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned for not more than 10 years, or both.

Best Practices When Encountering SCE Tactics

- Exercise extreme officer safety
- Do not engage in debate; <u>you will be</u> <u>recorded</u>
- Prohibit cell phone use during encounter

Seize and document any false I.D. cards or license plates

Verify identity

• Notify Intelligence Unit and FBI/JTTF

Don't be intimidated
